BHARAT BHAVAN

Inaugurated by the former prime minister of India, Smt. Indira Gandhi on Feb. 13, 1982, BHARAT BHAVAN is a multi-art complex, providing interactive proximity to the verbal, the visual and the performing arts. It is a place for contemporary articulation, exploration, reflection and innovation. It aspires to provide creative and provocative milieu to those who would like to contribute something new and meaningful, daring and visionary, exciting and insightful to the contemporary scene in the arts, poetry, theatre and music. It houses the best and lasting creativity that is being evolved in the country, whether in the cities or in the villages or in the jungles. It hopes to manifest the vulnerable glories, struggles and agonies, and visions of contemporary artists. Bharat Bhavan is a centre for innovation and creativity, for the pursuit of classics and tradition, and for wide participation in the cultural upsurge.

BHARAT BHAVAN *consists of the following units:*

ROOPANKAR - *The Museum of Fine Arts and Folk & Tribal Arts, Graphic Workshop, Ceramic Workshop and Design Unit.*

RANG MANDAL - *A Theatre Repertory.*

VAGARTH - *A Centre of Indian Poetry.*

ANAHAD - *A Centre of Classical and Folk Music.*

CHHAVI - *A Film Unit.*

ROOPANKAR MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS

ROOPANKAR is the only museum of fine arts in India which houses both contemporary, urban and folk-tribal art. Attached to the museum is a fully equipped print making workshop, ceramic workshop, design unit, archival section and facilities for stone carving and bronze casting. These facilities have been made available not only for urban artists but also for artists from the countryside, in the hope of setting up a dialogue and confrontation for opening up new avenues of creative activities. Roopankar is also deeply committed to the global movement in arts. It holds individual and group exhibitions of the art works from within the country, and abroad, as well.

Roopankar held its First Bharat Bhavan Biennial of International Prints in the year 1989 and since then it has organised eight more international print biennials in the year 1991, 1995, 1997, 2001, 2004, 2006 and 2008. Print makers of outstanding excellence are invited to represent as the members of an International Jury to select the works for the biennial exhibition and declare Bharat Bhavan Grand Prize Awards. RULES OF PARTICIPATION

1. The Biennial Exhibition comprises of two categories of participants :
 - (a) **INVITEE CATEGORY:** Print makers are directly invited to send two prints of their own choice to be exhibited. Prints of the invited artists will not be subjected to a scrutiny but will be put before the jury for the consideration of the awards.
 - (b) **OPEN CATEGORY:** The print makers from any country in the world, may send upto three prints which will be submitted for the selection by a panel of international jury.
2. All prints are to be the original creation and should not have been executed before the year 2009.
3. Prints are acceptable in various mediums including digital print, mixed media and mono print, excluding photographs or xero-graphed prints. However, the photographic technique may be used for making a print.
4. The artists must specifically indicate whether the prints sent are :
FOR COMPETITION or **NOT FOR COMPETITION.**

AWARDS

FOUR AWARDS OF EQUAL AMOUNT OF Rs. 1,00,000/-

There will be four Bharat Bhavan Grand Prize Awards of Rs. 1,00,000 each in Indian currency. The Jury at its discretion may also declare "Honourable Mention Certificate Award" as well.

The decision of the international jury, appointed by the organisers, shall be final and no correspondence, with regard to the selection of the prints and awards, shall be entertained.

The Grand Prize awardees will be invited to receive their Grand Prize Awards at the Inaugural Function of the Biennial Exhibition on 16th April 2011. Awardees will be provided economy class air fare return tickets. Besides, the expenses on their 5-day stay, boarding and lodging at Bhopal, will also be taken care of by Bharat Bhavan.

Only Indian Honourable Mention Awardees will be invited to be felicitated at the inaugural function of the Biennial Exhibition. These awardees will be provided with to and fro A/C III railway fare from any part of India.

The prints of Grand Prize Awardees will remain in the Bharat Bhavan's permanent collection and will be shown in various exhibitions held from time to time.

The Grand Prize Awardees will have the option to hold a One-Person-Exhibition at Bharat Bhavan without any financial commitment.

SUBMISSION OF WORKS

1. All the prints are to be sent unmounted and rolled in a strong cardboard mailing tube by a registered mail only. The mailing tube has to have a maximum length of 80 cm. and diameter measuring 10 cm.
2. There are enclosed labels having Bharat Bhavan's address etc. which should be pasted on the mailing tube with the slip indicating **PRINTED MATERIAL ONLY - NO COMMERCIAL VALUE.**
3. **THE IDENTIFICATION SLIPS** with the name of the artist, the title of the work and other details should be attached properly at the back side of the submitted prints.
4. The organisers are responsible for taking care of all the submitted works, however, any loss or damage in the course of transit cannot be insured and so no claim shall be entertained in this regard.
5. The organisers will provide mounts and frames for all the selected prints.
6. All the artists whose works are selected by the jury, will be duly informed.
7. The organisers reserve the rights to photograph whether the awarded or any selected work for reproducing in the catalogue or to be used for publicity etc. such reproduced works will be duly accredited.
8. A copy of the Biennial Catalogue will be sent to the artists whose works are selected. .
9. The language of communication would be either Hindi or English.

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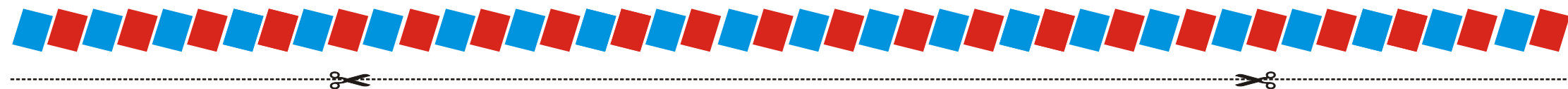
